### 1<sup>ST</sup> KINGS CHAPTER 2: FROM DAVID TO SOLOMON

- David is now "sleeping with his ancestors"
- No doubt there were more enemies that David warned about than the ones listed: Joab and *Shimei*
- Adonijah, David's son by Haggith, comes calling on Bathsheba



#### **ADONIJAH TAKES A HUGE RISK**

- Adoniyah tells Bat-Sheva that the throne rightfully belongs to him !!
- However he accepts that YHWH has given it to Shlomo
- Adoniyah asks to marry David's former nursemaid Avishag
- Bathsheba assumed that this was a small thing and innocently took the request to Solomon



## SHLOMO SEES THROUGH THE DECEPTION



- Solomon showed his mother great respect
- David's inner court knew that *Avishag* was just a servant, but the people of Israel saw her as part of David's Harem
- Solomon said Adonijah's next move would be to reaffirm *Evyatar* as High Priest, and then Joab as General of the Army

### ADONIJAH IS EXECUTED

- Was Solomon right to kill Adonijah?
- Rabbis say that Adonijah acknowledged that Shlomo was God's *mashiach* (anointed one)
- So for Adonijah to continue to try for the throne was similar to Saul trying to keep God's mashiach David from becoming king
- This was righteous justice and not murder





#### THE KING DEALS WITH EVYATAR



- 2 High Priests in Israel,
  Evyatar and Tzadok
- There can NOT be 2 legitimate High Priests!
- Evyatar, line of Eli, descendant of Ithamar
- > Tzadok line of Eleazar
- Evyatar banished to Anathoth
- > 1st Samuel 2:27 end
- Fulfillment of prophecy of the end of *Eli's* line

## YO'AV FLEES TO GIBEON AND GRABS THE HORNS OF THE ALTAR



- It was Gibeon because the Tent of YHWH was there
- B'nayah finds Joab but Joab won't leave the altar
- B'nayah returns to Solomon with the dilemma
- Vss. 31 -33 King Shlomo explains the Law on the matter of blood-guilt
- There is NO sanctuary for a murderer, not even the altar

# NO SACRIFICE FOR MURDER

- Lesser crimes may be atoned for with an animal sacrifice
- Num.35:30 31 "..the murderer is to be put to death....
- ➤ Deut.19:8 13 "..if someone...strikes him with a death blow...do not pity him..."





## UNPUNISHED MURDER DEFILES THE COMMUNITY







- The community is responsible to God for righteous justice to be carried out
- King Solomon bore the responsibility for justice
- Killing Joab would remove the blood-guilt from David's family
- Not all killing is murder
- God commands that the life of the criminal is forfeit for murder


#### **EVAYATAR SENT TO ANATHOTH**

- Joab's body taken to his family tomb in the midbar, probably Bethlehem
- Midbar = wilderness, uncultivated place
- Solomon did NO wrong in executing Joab
- Solomon did RIGHT in removing *Evyatar*
- However Shimei is another matter





- Shimei told not to cross the Kidron Valley
- Quarantined inside Jerusalem for life
- > 1) Put on notice he was being watched
- 2) Taken away from his tribe of Benjamin so he couldn't foment trouble
- 3) Put in a situation where he was bound to make a misstep!





### SOLOMON CONDEMNS SHIMEI

- Shimei foolishly goes after 2 escaped slaves, and upon his return is brought to Shlomo
- Solomon says Shimei swore an oath to obey him, but there is no hint of that in the Scriptures
- By customs of the day Shimei's death was just
- But by God's standards his death was not just!
- Shlomo now had blood on his hands
