


- Elijah operated in the north
- Elisha operated mostly in the north, but also in the south
- Elisha's spiritual gifts went even further than Eliyahu's
- Elijah and Elisha were counterbalances
- Prophet Guilds represent a kind of replacement "priesthood"
- These common prophets kept the Word of God alive in the land





### THE CHOICE OF IGNORANCE

- Starting with Jeroboam, the people of the north were barred from going to the Temple
- Leaders who clung to YHWH were targets for extermination
- Layman were seen as non-conformists
- God used the prophet guilds to teach His Word to the people, so that they had a choice
- Ignorance would not be an excuse when divine judgment came
- In modern times, Christianity is seen as an obstacle to peace
- Faithful followers are seen as unintelligent bigots with phobias

#### ELISHA IS DEVASTATED

- Elisha tells Haza'el that Ben-Hadad will not die of his illness, but will die of another cause
- Elisha becomes speechless and starts to cry
- Elisha upbraided Israel's kings, but loved the Hebrew people
- But what he was about to do would bring killing, pillaging, and oppression upon his own people



## ELISHA PREDICTS THAT HAZA'EL WILL MURDER MANY HEBREWS



- Haza'el feigns innocence
- Elisha knew what would happen as a result of his anointing of Haza'el
- > 1st Kings 19:15 17
- Later, King Yehu of Judah will also kill Hebrews
- It is even predicted that ELISHA will put Hebrews to death!

#### HALLELUYAH??? REALLY???


- Why are Christians often so joyous as we hear sermons about the End Times?

- Elisha did not look happily heavenward, he wept and despaired at what was coming even though it was God's will






## THE UNHOLY INTERMARRIAGE OF THE TWO MONARCHIES

- Haza'el returns to Aram and murders Ben-Hadad, becomes King of Syria
- Names of the kings becomes confusing
- Y'horam a King of Judah, another Y'horam King of Israel....at the same time!
- Daughter of Achav and Jezebel was Athalia
- King of Judah married Athalia



# JUDAH STEPS ONTO THE SLIPPERY SLOPE TO EVIL



- The ONLY reason God didn't judge Judah was for King David's sake
- > 2Chronicles 21:1 7
- King Y'horam of Judah immediately killed his brothers to possess their inheritance
- King of Judah mixed the religion of Judah with pragmatic politics by marrying Athalia

#### THE REBELLION OF EDOM

- God punished Judah by the rebellion of Edom
- It was NOT the King of Israel who attacked Edom
- Judah's army attacked Edom, became surrounded, and the nonprofessional militia ran for home
- Livnah an Edomite bordercity also rebelled



## THE SOURCE OF THE EVIL? JEZEBEL AND ATHALIA



- 2 Chronicles 21: 8 end
- Achazyah replaced his father Y'horam
- He reigned only 1 year
- Died an agonizing death
- 2nd Kings pinpoints Jezebel and her daughter Athalia as the source of the spirit of evil
- King Achazyah of Judah related by blood to the northern kingdom dynasty of Achav and Omri

## GOD'S PATTERNS ARE HIS CHIEF GOVERNING DYNAMIC

- The 2 Kingdoms of Judah and Ephraim/Israel became closely aligned, because the kings were related by blood
- In a joint war effort they tried to retake the city of Ramoth-Gilead in the Trans-Jordan
- King Y'horam of Israel was wounded and went to his Jezreel palace to recover
- 14 years earlier, Achazyah's grandfather Jehoshaphat united with the King of Israel to fight to regain Ramoth-Gilead
- The King of Israel was killed in the process, and the pattern would repeat
