Upon This ROCK Matthew 16:18


- Peter is now the spokesman of the Messianic movement
- > He was the logical choice as one of the original 12
- At Caesarea Philippi Yeshua said to Peter: You are the Rock, and upon this Rock I shall build my community"

WHY 12 DISCIPLES AND NOT 11?



- Yeshua told His followers that they shouldn't worry about future things, but rather the here and now
- A special power was coming that would enable the disciples to obey their prime directive: take the Good News to the entire planet
- > Matt.19:28
- > 12 thrones, judging the 12 tribes


THE BETRAYAL OF THE AGES




- Judas's betrayal was foretold by King David
- "He was one of us.....assigned part of our work"
- Judas, by all accounts, was a Believer
- Generally, no Christian claim that Judas went to Heaven
- Advocating for Christ, identifying yourself as a follower, is not sufficient (Judas did that!)
- We must sincerely acknowledge WHAT Jesus is (Son of God and Savior) along with WHO He is (Yeshua of Nazareth)
- Matthew 16:13 15
 James 2:18 20

THE 12 ARE RESTORED


- Peter quotes Psalm 109: "Let someone else take his place as a supervisor"
- The qualifications: Present with Christ from the beginning of His ministry, present at His ascension, & witness to His resurrection
- Yosef Bar-Sabba & Mattiyahu were qualified
- Casting of lots chose Mattiyahu (Matthias)



ACTS CHAPTER 2: WHAT THE FATHER PROMISED




- Probably 1 week to the day from Ascension to Pentecost
- This is the starting point to establish context for understanding Peter & Paul
- Pentekostes = 50
- Shavuot = weeks
- Pentecost not a new holiday created by Christians
- Shavuot (Pentecost) was 1300 years old!



- Shavuot (Pentecost) part of a system of holy days
- > 1st: **Pesach** 2nd: **Matza** 3rd: **Bikkurim**
- First 3 happen in quick succession in Nissan
- > Then a 7 week lull until **Shavuot**
- > Both Bikkurim and Shavuot are "firstfruits" festivals
- Bikkurim = Barley harvest
 Shavuot = Wheat harvest
- Tishri starts with Yom Teruah, then Yom Kippur, and finally Sukkot

DUAL MEANING OF SHAVUOT



- Ex. 19:1 Torah given on 3rd month after leaving Egypt
- 2nd and 3rd centuries A.D.
 Talmud tractates Shabbat
 & Pesachim
- 2nd and 3rd centuries B.C. Book of Jubilees
- At time of Christ Judaism BELIEVED that the Torah was given at Mt. Sinai on Shavuot
- Book of Acts written according to that same premise


- Means to discuss, comment, interpret
 Scripture
- > Ex. 20:18
- Targum Pseudo Jonathan says giving of Torah came with flames of fire
- Ex. 20:10 HEBREW says: "...saw the thunderings"
- The Mekhilta also speaks of this event

MIDRASH






- Midrash Tanhuma: "....the voice went out and was divided into 7 voices....(then) into 70 tongues, so that all nations would hear...."
- Rabbis taught that the Torah was given on Mt. Sinai with flames and thundering
- > Thundering in the Bible was depicted as God's voice
- Genesis 10 says that there were 70 nations



- ➤ Luke portrays the coming of the Holy Spirit on Shavuot as the 2nd coming of the Torah
- Visible, noisy, flames and fire, many languages!
- > Jeremiah 31:30 "I will put my Torah within them..."
- > Isaiah 2:3 "....out of Zion will go forth Torah...."
- Disciples were at Mt. Zion in Jerusalem when the Holy Spirit came upon them



THE RENEWED COVENANT

- Holy Spirit came on Shavuot, in Jerusalem, with same signs and miracles as at Mt. Sinai
- It all happened within the framework of Jewish thoughts and culture
- This time the Holy Spirit embedded the same Torah internally in humans
- Christ's worshippers can now have a deeper devotion to following the Torah and obeying the Lord
