



KNOWLEDGE VS. CHANGE

- Behavior change of new Believers was slow to come
- Believing Jews saw trust in Yeshua as a natural progression of their current faith
- Believing gentiles put one foot in The Way, and kept the other in the gentile world
- Jews had no demands put on them to change
- Gentiles were told to change by the Jerusalem Council
- Changes involved diet, idolatry and immorality

EPHESIAN BELIEVERS CHANGED






- Diaspora Jews made lifestyle concessions
- Jewish exorcists used pagan ways to oust demons
- Jews & gentiles who came to belief usually made no immediate changes
- AFTER the experience of Paul healing and dealing with demons, versus Jewish exorcists failing, true change in Ephesian Believers happened!
- Coming to Christ MUST pass from theory to application for it to be of real value

PAUL DECIDED "BY THE SPIRIT"

- "Some time later" a Hebrew literary device that changes the subject
- Paul & the Spirit had input on his decision of where to go after leaving Ephesus
- Do NOT be paralyzed waiting for a list of specifics from God !!
- Paul knew that Rome was God's key destination

CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE POOR

- ➤ Romans 15:23 26
- ➤ 1Cor. 16:1 4
- Collection of funds for the poor is heavily on Paul's mind
- Timothy reappears on the scene in Ephesus
- Paul sent Timothy and Erastus ahead of him to
 - Macedonia
 - Paul would stay in "Asia"

ARTEMIS FERTILITY GODDESS


- Demetrius, head of the Silversmith guild, ignited a disturbance
- Riot started on account of principles of The Way that upset the silversmiths
- Silversmiths' main business was associated with Artemis
- Artemis, Ashteroth, Eostre, Ishtar, Easter all the same
- Artemis a special protector and benefactor of Ephesus




JEWS DID NOT DENOUNCE IDOLS

- Artemis Temple was 400 ft. X 200 ft.
- Artemis worship had a major impact on regional economy
- Jews only made laws against idol use for Jews
- Paul spoke out against idols in Athens, but that didn't cause much outcry
- In Ephesus, idol making was their life's blood






"Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!"



- Economic ruin and loss of honor for Artemis will result from the Jews saying that idols aren't real
- If Artemis lost prestige, she would lose her power and position among the gods....and so would Ephesus!
- Gaius & Aristarchus dragged with the crowd into the theatre
- Paul wanted to confront the mob, but advised not to for fear of his life


RIOT WAS ANTI-JEWISH

- Alexander, a Jew, tries to speak to the crowd but is shouted down
- Gentiles saw The Way as a Jewish religion
- The Jews saw The Way as a Jewish religion
- City Clerk finally able to calm everyone down
- He begins by diplomatically showing solidarity with the crowd




CITY CLERK SAYS THE JEWS ARE INNOCENT OF INSULTING ARTEMIS

- City Clerk says no need to be so upset; it is selfevident that Artemis is real and above reproach
- The Sacred Stone is also proof
- Islam venerates The Black Stone as holy
- These are meteorites
- Ekklesia = crowd, assembly
- Christians usually translate ekklesia as Church
