- Acts 19:21 "I must visit Rome"
- Acts 27:23 24 "You have to stand before the Emperor"
- Paul expected to speak to Jews in the synagogues of Rome, not to the powerful elite rulers of the Roman Empire
- Rome the capital of <u>gentile</u> world gov't & the <u>gentile</u> Christian Church
- When Messiah returns, world gov't will go back to Jerusalem and operate as a theocracy

PAUL DEFENDS HIMSELF

- Roman tribune is still not sure what Paul has done
- Not the common Jews who wanted Paul dead
- Zealots were supernationalists who hated gentiles
- Scholars have trouble pinpointing what crime Paul had committed
- Paul insists on his good Jewish character, but is struck on his mouth for saying it



Paul rarely discusses matters in technical terms or does he offer minute nuances





Christians stand at the head of the list when it comes to defending manmade doctrines more than God's commands Christians and Jews claim their doctrines and God's Word as essentially one in the same The route to modernization of Christianity is to go back to the earliest days of our faith



- Paul doesn't declare innocence, he declares he has a good Jewish character
- Paul calls High Priest Hananyah (Ananias) a white-washed wall.....he is accusing him of being a fake, a phony
- Paul of course knew he was the High Priest due to the garments he was wearing
- Did Paul sully his Apostolic credentials by responding that way?

YESHUA WAS ALSO SLAPPED

➢ John 18:19 – 23

- Yeshua struck by Caiaphas, Paul by Ananias, and both had words with High Priest
- Paul knew by Ananias' garments that he was the High Priest
- Paul's dialogue was tongue in cheek, and sarcastic
- Perhaps Paul did sin according to the letter of the Law of Moses





PAUL INSTIGATES A FIGHT

- Paul announces that he is STILL a Pharisee
- Says his case revolves around his belief in resurrection
- Huge argument erupts
- Law (*nomos*) with Josephus means *Halakhah*, not the Law of Moses (Torah)
- Pharisees led the masses via the synagogue

CHAOS AT THE SANHEDRIN



 Sadducees are wealthy aristocrats who form the senior Priesthood
Claim to strictly follow

- Claim to strictly follow ONLY the Law of Moses, and shun the Traditions of the Pharisees, but are corrupt and aloof
- The issue of resurrection puts the Pharisees on Paul's side

> 1Cor.15:16 – 17

 Lysias has to remove Paul from the scene due to the mayhem at the Sanhedrin

PAUL IS ENCOURAGED BY THE LORD



- Paul sent back to his cell
- God says that soon Paul is going to witness to the Emperor of Rome!
- Paul's comfort is secondary to God's purposes
- Frustrated Zealots plot a plan to take Paul from the Roman guard
- Zealots so passionate about defending their Jewishness that they'll give up their lives
- Paul seen as a traitor to Jewishness

PAUL'S NEPHEW TO THE RESCUE

> 40 men plan to attack the Roman garrison

- They went to the High Priest and told him their plan
- Nephew somehow found out about the plot to kill his uncle
- Nephew tells Paul and then Lysias



PAUL TO BE TAKEN TO CAESAREA



Lysias orders 2 Centurions to assemble troops for a quick march to Caesarea Maritima

- Will leave at the 3rd hour of the night to avoid the conspirators
- Romans divided a day into daytime and nighttime
- Each had 12 hours
 - An hour was a division of time, not a measurement of time
 A daytime hour was not the same length as a nighttime hour
