
#### **ROLLING BACK THE VEIL**

- The Gospels are NOT a radical innovation within Israelite biblical tradition
- They represent a conservative RETURN to the biblical foundation
- Jews and Christians tend to suppress early biblical truths because BOTH want to maintain a separation
- Accepting Yeshua as Messiah was born within a branch of Judaism










# NEW TESTAMENT RELIES ON DANIEL

- Concepts of Trinity and a Divine Messiah around before Yeshua was born
- If Daniel is a hoax, then the New Testament has credibility issues
- Modern evangelical Christianity mostly interested in Daniel for its End-Times information, but not for the redemption theology found here

## THE COMING OF THE SON OF MAN

- At first, son of man (ben adam) same as "human being"
- Psalm 80 implies the son of man is MORE than human
- Son of Man means the opposite of how it seems
- Son of God is a concept that came hundreds of years before Yeshua and did NOT suggest divinity
- > Early on, son of God spoke of the human nature

### MASHIACH: THE ANOINTED ONE



- Mashiach = Christos = Christ = Messiah
- > John 1:41
- All kings of Israel were Mashiach
- They were all anointed with oil, symbolic of God electing and setting them apart
- NO divinity was meant by Mashiach, only a human Israelite King closely connected to the God of Israel

- The Lord "adopted" each Israelite King
- > 1 Chron. 28:6
- Father/son relationship established between God and Hebrew King
- God decided to give the throne of Israel permanently to King David's dynasty
- > 2 Sam. 7:12 14
- Foregone conclusion among Jews that all further Davidic Kings were "sons of God"
- Doesn't mean that the "son of God" was a divine king




### BABYLON ENDS DAVID'S DYNASTY

- Babylon conquers Judah
- King Zedekiah blinded for rebelling against Nebuchadnezzar
- Jews finally went home, but no identifiable Davidic king available
- Also no Israelite kingdom for a king to rule over, only foreign control of the land
- Would take a miraculous act of God to create, find, or resurrect a Davidic King and create a kingdom for him to rule over
- Concept of King as a Redeemer









- New Testament from the Jewish worldview
- Mark 1:1 "The beginning of the good news of Yeshua the Messiah, Son of God"
- Son of God = long awaited Davidic King (human king)
- Mashiach = anointed king
- NOT meant to show divinity
- Later Mark switches titles of Yeshua to Son of Man
- Son of Man referred to Daniel 7, and thereby claimed Yeshua's divine nature

### PROFOUND PROGRESSIVE REVELATION

- Daniel 7:13 Two distinct divine figures: Ancient One and the Son of Man
- All sovereignty on earth is given the Son of Man by the Ancient of Days
- Coming on the clouds is always associated with a divine being
- New theological concept for Israel: a human appearing deity, called the Son of Man







### DANIEL UPSET AND CONFUSED

- Did God cross over a line that HE had drawn?
- Gods in human form were considered idolatry
- Son of Man's attributes:
- Human & Divine
- Comes in the clouds
- Occupy throne, in heaven, next to God
- Given dominion of earth
- "Like" a Son of Man


### SON OF MAN AND ANCIENT OF DAYS



- Daniel is picturing a human being
- Not FULLY human, so similar to situation with lion, bear, and leopard
- "Son of Man" became title for this mysterious being, but son of man still meant human being as well
- And "older God" alongside a "younger God"

#### **TRINITY**

- Different denominational views of the Trinity
- Different views of the substance of Christ
- Apparition, born a human THEN became God, fully human but Holy Spirit more powerful in Him than anyone before or after, and more
- OT God is "old", bloody, severe, wrathful, legalistic
- NT God is "young", love, mercy, no rules



#### THE HOLY ONES



- Daniel 7:21, 22, 27
- Holy Ones receive the Kingdom
- Daniel 7:13,14
- Son of Man receives the Kingdom
- Judaism says Holy Ones are Israel, therefore so is the Son of Man
- A duality, both being true
- > 2 Tim.2:11, 12
- > Rev. 2:26, 27
- > 1 Cor. 6:2, 3
