- Two parts to Daniel 9:
- 1) Prayer of confession
- 2) Prophecy of the 70 weeks
- ▶ 1<sup>st</sup> stage of prophetic / fulfillment is Babylon
- 2nd stage of fulfillment is Media-Persia
- The 4 gentile world empires of the visions ONLY start with Daniel's time and go forward




#### WHEN DOES THE 70 YEARS BEGIN?

3<sup>RD</sup> ATTACK 586-7 B.C.




- Why doesn't Daniel see any signs of the end of the exile?
- Daniel an expert in calculating years
- Was the 70 years:
- > 1) a precise 70 years?
- > 2) an approximation?
- > 3) symbolic?
- When does God reckon the 70 years begins?




- Seferim = books Does NOT always mean Scripture
- Jeremiah's words were written down in a book, not handed down word of mouth by tradition
- Daniel prayed in the attitude of mourning
- Standard Hebrew mourning procedures: Sackcloth, ashes over the head, fasting
- Daniel 9 in Hebrew (chapter 2 7 in Aramaic) because focus is on the Jews
- Prayer is to Adonai Elohim (Lord God)

## ATTRIBUTES OF GOD

- Confession accompanied with a repentant attitude
- God as "Great and Dreadful"
- Great = all-powerful, unstoppable
- Dreadful = terrible, frightening
- $\triangleright$  Merism = the 2 extremes plus everything in between (A Z)
- God as faithful to keep covenant and to show grace
- Chesed = grace, mercy, lovingkindness and more








## HOW TO RECEIVE CHESED

- MUST love AND obey God
- In OT and NT "obedience" means to obey God's written commandments
- Modern Christianity says obedience is now subjective
- Matt.5:17 19 "Don't think that I have come to abolish the Torah or the Prophets.....until heaven and earth pass away.."





- Christ said He did NOT abolish the Torah!
- Did Paul say that He did?
- Hypothetical: if so, whose word do we accept? The Master or his student?
- Paul did NOT say the Law was abolished by Christ
- Will the Torah ever be abolished? YES!!
- Rev. 21:1
- Heaven and earth did not pass away at the Cross
- Afterward, there will be no more need for a Torah, for there will be no more sin!!





# "..an exhaustive expression of a consciousness of sin and guilt"

- Daniel, despite his piousness, does not separate himself from his people
- Daniel's definition of sin? Turning aside from God's commandments
- Prophets sent to warn Kings, tribal leaders, common folks
- God was fair and just; He reacted according to His people's rebellion
- Prayed and confessed on behalf of all 12 tribes
- The CURSE of the Law has fallen upon all Israel, they should have expected it










# WHAT IS LAWLESSNESS?

- Is Salvation a limitless Get Out of Jail Free card?
- ➤ Matt.7:21 23
- What "law" is Christ talking about?
- Roman law? Governments and states laws? Rabbinical laws? Sharia laws?
- The lawlessness is speaking of the Laws of Moses
- Lawlessness = Torah-less-ness

# A CHANCE TO CHANGE

- God warns us of our sin, and then provides an opportunity to change
- God is a God of unchanging patterns
- Because of Judah's sins, Jerusalem lay desolate, and the Jews are in exile
- The destroyed Temple is a monument to rebellion, tragedy, and disgrace






## SHEMA, SALACH, QASHAB

- Shema = listen and actively respond
- Hear is only ½ of the meaning, must include DO
- Salach = pardon
- > A divine pardon that can only flow from God to man
- The guilt of the sin remains, ONLY the consequence for the sin is set-aside and postponed
- Qashab = be attentive
- To "lean in" on a conversation, with acute interest
- Daniel is asking God: 1) Hear and act on his request
   2) set-aside and postpone Judah's punishment for sins
   3) carefully listened and focus on Daniel's confession
  - and repentance

### **GABRIEL BRINGS AN ORACLE**



- Angel Gabriel interrupts Daniel's praying
- > *Ish* = man, male
- Gibbor = mighty man, a warrior leader
- Arrived at the time of the Erev Minchah (evening sacrifice) 3 – 4 p.m.
- Gabriel tells Daniel that he is loved and treasured
- The "vision" is Gabriel
