

DEFEAT OF THE AMORITES

- Vs. 24 "Let the Holy War begin!"
- The first group Israel is to fight are the Amorites
- This is because in the "Unholy" war of rebellion, the Amorites defeated Israel
- Very similar to God's Holy War against Pharaoh and Egypt
- King Sihon refused the offer of peace and attacked Israel
- Holy War is a war led BY God, not a war "in God's name"
- The Law of Herem is central in true Holy War
- Jihad is NOT Biblical Holy War!



FREE WILL?




- That "God never interferes with Man's free will" is too simplistic
- Yehoveh hardened Pharaoh's heart AND he hardened King Sihon's heart
- In the Bible the HEART is considered the seat of intellect, both conscious and unconscious
- The HEART NEVER had anything to do with emotion and feelings!
- Heart = Brain = Mind in the Bible
- It was late era Hellenists who made the Heart to be the center of emotional love (erotic love)

GOD'S WILL IS ABOVE HUMAN WILL

- Free Will is the human version of God's sovereignty
- God has set LIMITS on human free will
- Jonah found that there was NO escape from the Lord's will
- Paul: "....when I want to do right, I do evil....."
- Our free will is susceptible to other forces
- Somehow history unfolds with men's free wills being used in a pre-determined way







DEUTERONOMY CHAPTER 3

- Much is a repeat of Numbers 21
 - Victory over Og
- Moses is NOW speaking to the 2nd generation of the Exodus
 - The 1st generation has died out
 - Eventual area called the Galilee



AREA CONQUERED

- 60 Walled cities plus many unprotected villages
- Mt. Hermon was the northernmost point
- Hermon = Hermon Sirion
 = Senir
- Tablelands = area of Reuben
- King Og was the last of the Rephaim



DIVIDING the TRANS-JORDAN

- > Yair son of Manasseh
- > Machir
- Yair and Machir were CLANS of Manasseh
- Son = ben more often means grandson or any male member of the clan
- Kinnereth = Sea of Galilee
- Dead Sea = Salt Sea


ISRAEL WAS TO ACT AS A GROUP

- Reuben, Gad and ½ of Manasseh sent crack troops to help conquer Canaan
- A condition of their receiving the Trans-Jordan area
- Joshua 22:1 Joshua releases these troops from their obligation
- God-principle: All who are called by the Lord's name are to behave as a single group




MOSES PLEADS

- Moses says it was <u>"because of"</u> the people that he sinned against the Lord
- God says "ENOUGH!"
- > The issue is **justice**
- The rebellious generation perished for their sins, therefore so must Moses
- Moses did NOT die "for the sake" or the people as did Yeshua
- Moses' death did NOT substitute for the people's death as did Christ's



Do what is righteous, and let the chips fall where they may.....

- The fate of the leader and the followers are bound together
- The leader MUST do what is right in God's eyes no matter the personal consequences
- BUT.....the reward is often some form of martyrdom
- > A leader is not to expect applause from the world
- Moses officially selects Joshua as the new leader
- Joshua was NOT the new "Mediator" of Israel
- Joshua was the new MILITARY leader of Israel



DEUTERONOMY CHAPTER 4

- A man's last words
- What would YOU like to say to those you loved about what life has taught you?
 - Moses is pleading with the people to carry on the good work the Lord has begun
- Moses sermon revolves around a history lesson
- Their historical experiences VALIDATE and set the CONTEXT for the laws the Lord has given to Israel

"....so that you may live...."



- Proverbs 19:16 "..he who has regard for his life pays regard to the commands..."
- Hebrew too all this literally
- They believed that obedience brought a full lifespan while rebellion brought early death
- Oldest Israelite to enter Canaan was about 58 – 59 years old!

SHEMA!!

- Shema usually translated as hear or hearken
- > Formal name for Deut 6:4 "hear O Israel"
- Shema is an instruction to ACT!
- In our modern vocabulary belief does NOT mean the same thing as trust
- In our modern vocabulary hear/hearken should be replaced with obey or observe
- ➤ Deut. 6:4 " OBEY, O Israel! YHWH is our God, YHWH is one! And you shall love YHWH your God with all your MIND and with all your soul and with all your might"
