





#### CONCLUSION OF THE TORAH

- Book of Joshua often called "the 6th book" of the Torah
- Deut 34 ends at the border of the Promised Land, Israel is still in Moab
- The Book of Joshua takes Israel across the Jordan and into the land of Canaan

#### **DEUT 33:9**



Referring to the Golden Calf of Ex. 32

Levites stood with Moses and God


 Those who were loyal put to the sword those who worshipped the Calf

Levites killed their own parents and children

The Lord often uses humans to bring about His justice

#### YESHUA TEACHES TO "HATE KIN" IN THE CONTEXT OF DEUT 33:9

- Luke 14:25 compares to Deut 33 and Ex. 32
- Hate = rejection, disregard
- Luke 14 is NOT over and against "honor your mother and father"
- Believers will be killing non-Believers at Armageddon, with Messiah leading the way





#### BENJAMIN

Because Levi "hated" their own kin, they were rewarded with the Priesthood

Benjamin a buffer region

- Between Judah and Ephraim
- Jerusalem originally in Benjamin






## THE JOSEPH TRIBES: EPHRAIM, MANASSEH

- Fruitfulness is the primary blessing
- > **Yosef** = may he increase
- Ephraim = God has made me fertile
- Meged = bounty, abundance
- Moon measures months and seasons
- Mountains produced trees, wood, limestone, precious metals, food

### THE SPLIT FIRSTBORN BLESSING

- Joseph received HALF of the firstborn blessing
- Judah received the OTHER HALF of the firstborn blessing
- Joseph's half went to Ephraim
- Ephraim received the double-portion
- Judah received the right to rule over Israel



## ISRAEL IS DIVIDED INTO TWO KINGDOMS



Solomon dies in 925 B.C.

Judah controls the south

Judah absorbed Benjamin

Ephraim controls the north

Ephraim absorbed the other 10 tribes

#### ZEBULUN AND ISSACHAR



- Zebulun and Issachar formed a partnership
- Merchants and traders
- Gad's blessing is that it's population is increased
- Gad received perhaps the best pasturelands of all the tribes
- Produced highly trained troops
- It's land was OUTSIDE of the land of Canaan


#### DAN MIGRATED NORTH


- Originally assigned the lowlands of Canaan
- Bordered the Philistines
- Naphtali on the west shore of the Sea of Galilee
- Nazareth was in Naphtali
- Asher blessed with abundance



## WHAT HAPPENED TO SIMEON?


- Simeon is missing from the list of Moses' blessings
- It was Levi and Simeon who led the raid on Shechem
- Both received curses from Jacob
- Simeon became a very small tribe, surrounded by Judah's tribe
- Simeon became absorbed and lost as a separate tribal identity






## MOSES BLESSES 12 TRIBES JESUS BLESSES 12 DISCIPLES


- Judas Iscariot
- Iscariot either a location or a play on words meaning "Sicarri"
- Sicarri were assassins for the Zealot party
- Judas son of Simon
- Simon, Simeon, Shim'on all the same name



## JUDAS WAS FROM THE TRIBE OF SIMEON

- Simeon, cursed, is left out of the Blessing of Moses
- Judas of the tribe of Simeon is cursed and left out of the blessing of Christ
- The prophetic pattern is self-evident
- Moses ends poem by blessing all the tribes as a whole







#### DEUTERONOMY 34: THE DEATH OF MOSES

- "Grandfather" Moses ascends Mt. Nebo and there God buries him
- Nebo is opposite the ancient city of Jericho

# The Promised Land was CANAAN!

- There is NO alternative place
- The Lord chose Canaan and it is HIS!
- Our last several presidents have had no interest in honoring the Biblical Holy Lands
- This is a great offense to the Lord, and there will be consequences





## MOSES "SEES" THE LAND

- "The Lord showed him
- the whole land"
- Moses "saw" in a supernatural way
- Moses' burial place is unknown
- No shrines could be built and worshipped there
- Moses mourned for 30 days
- > 120 years old at death

## MOSES UNEQUALLED AS A PROPHET..... UNTIL

- Only Yeshua surpasses Moses as a prophet
- > Yeshua is our Redeemer
- All other prophets could NOT undo or add to Moses' words
- No religious leader can undo or add to Moses' words
- Yeshua did NOT undo or add to Moses' words <u>Matt.5:17-19</u>
- > TORAH IS LIFE!!
