### MUCH OF EPHRAIM BECAME ASSIMILATED INTO ASSYRIA

- > About 5% of Ephraim remained in the land, the rest were deported
- Intermarried and intermixed with gentiles
- > Assimilation was DESIRED by Ephraim
- Not ALL Israelites who were deported became assimilated, some groups managed to stay together and keep tribal identities





Means Ephraim will grow into <u>"a fullness of gentile nations"</u>







# THE 144,000 WITNESSES




 Revelation 7

- > Two names added to list: Joseph and Levi


# EKEKIEL 37 EVENTS MUST OCCUR <u>AFTER</u> JUDAH CONQUERED BY BABYLON

- Must occur AFTER all 12 tribes have been scattered, because all 12 tribes must come back from among the nations
- Reunion of Judah and Ephraim occurs BEFORE the Great Tribulation
  SPECULATION: Could those in the white robes of Rev. 7 be Ephraim?




