


- Haggai records chronologically and historically
- No such thing as B.C. at that time, and no universally applied calendars
- Saying, "the 6th month of the 2nd year of Darius" means Haggai is using the Regnal calendar
- The 6<sup>th</sup> month is Elul, about the same as September, late summer/early fall season
- Harvesting was underway in Yehud (formerly Judah)




- Cyrus Cambyses Darius
- This address from God happened about 520 B.C.
- ▶ Luke 21: 22 24 Times (Age) of the Gentiles was already in effect, long before Yeshua, and it is still in effect today
- "Dabar YHWH" is a compound term = a prophetic revelation (it is NOT "the word of the <u>Lord</u>")



- "the word of YHWH" comes from the language and realm of ancient royal courts
- God's Divine Council consists of a caste of divine beings (elohim) who are the administrative rulers of Heavens
- Israelite thought pictured God as the great judge/king who sits above and proclaims oracles in collaboration with His Council
- This is how we are to understand what is being said

- Zerubbabel= seed of Babylon
- > A descendant of David
- Joshua High Priest, descended from proper High Priest line
- Zerubbabel is not Sheshbazzar
- Joshua spelledYehoshua or Yeshua
- Means Yehoveh saves
- Yeshua represents God's saving will

## ZERUBBABEL AND JOSHUA





- Vs. 2 is a rebuke of the Jews for not rebuilding God's House
- The Jews came home with more interest in reclaiming farms and land than rebuilding the Temple
- Building on the Temple had stopped for 15 years
- "Think about your lives" = ponder your designs and actions, and their consequences
- The problem is a lack of enthusiasm for rebuilding the Temple



The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives.

Deut 14:23 TLB

- Tithing is a commandment of God, not an option
- Prosperity Doctrine is nonsense!
- ➤ In Haggai, God says to look at the result of their disobedience to give to rebuild God's House
- God says in the rebuilding of the Temple, He "will be glorified"

## GOD'S GLORY






- > RSV Haggai 1:8
- Here, God's Glory does not mean "in His splendor"
- The Glory of God was, to the Hebrews, another manifestation of God!
- The cloud in Solomon's Temple was God's visible Glory
- > A double curse
- Vs. 9 "BECAUSE my house lies in ruins..."



- Better reading of vs. 9: "...what you have brought to the House, I have blown away..."
- The Altar was being used even though the Temple wasn't standing
- The Torah says that the smoke of the sacrifices is a sweet aroma to God... He is accepting the sacrifices
- Blown away means God blows the smoke away instead of inhaling it.... He is rejecting the sacrifices


## BABYLON WHY IS THERE A LACK?

The land is not producing due to not enough rain


 Drinking water for humans and animals had become scarce

Returning Jews not used to farming when rain was needed to water the crops

Haggai says their lack was due to not rebuilding the Temple



- Fearing God has two biblical meanings:1) allegiance, 2) a healthy trepidation
- Proverbs 9:10 "The fear of Adonai is the beginning of wisdom"
- Ignoring the Prophets is to ignore God's Word
- "I am with you" means Israel will be tangibly protected from sickness or an enemy



- > "Roused the spirit" means an arousal to action!
- Work began on the 24th day of the 6th month, so it had been only 23 days since Haggai gave God's oracle
- The Prophetic Word literally is what brings God's will into action
- Once the Word is announced, nothing can stop it
