


- To ignore or abrogate God's moral law code is the most fatal of follies

- Israel is without excuse because they had the Torah, given to them in writing
- Because of intentional disregard, the things God had told them they no longer thought were for them!

- Christ highlighted in the Sermon on the Mount that the Law continued without change
- Most eating of meat was tied to sacrifices
- Israel's sacrifices are so perverted, God doesn't want them
- So, a person ought to just keep the meat for himself



> TITHING MADE SIMPLE


- > 1) Do NOT give without open heart and hand
- > 2) Tithing is only for a Believer, and it is commanded
- > 3) Know who and to what you are giving
- > 4) Tithing will NOT buy God's favor
- > 5) Tithing means 1/10th That is a biblical minimum



- Israel resorted to a systemized approach to sacrifice
- Until recently, their prosperity and peace seemed to indicate the system worked well
- Important to know God's name, and to identify Him that way
- Deuteronomy 28:64 69

- The mention of Judah is the addition of a later editor
- Israel said they built Temples to "God", but their "God" was of their own image
- "Forgot their maker"
- Shakach = ignore, neglect, wither away
- God says He will destroy Israel's strongholds with fire
- These are all Covenant curses



HOSEA CHAPTER 9



- ▶ Vss. 1 6 From merry making to mourning
- God assures Israel their festivals will end
- Just as Gomer was an unfaithful wife to Hosea, so is Israel an unfaithful "wife" to God
- Either Bikkurim (Firstfruits) or Shavuot (Pentecost)




- Threshing floors also used for celebrations and parties
- ➤ Ruth 3:1 8
- Hundreds of years after Ruth, in Northern Israel the situation is not so innocent
- As a consequence that which is prepared on the threshing floor (grain) and in a press (oil) will no longer provide for their needs



- Israel has lost their privilege of the Promised Land
- ➤ Deuteronomy 11:16 17
- Once exiled, there can be no "clean" food
- Ezekiel 4:13
- Sacrifices consisted of 3 parts: the meat, the grain (*minchah*), and the wine (libation)



- The effects of being kicked out of the Promised Land more extensive than having to move!
- God was blocking the redemption
- Lechem onim = food of mourning
- ➤ Deuteronomy 26:12 14
- Mourners ritually barred from the Temple



- Chag Yehoveh = Feast of Yehoveh = Sukkot
- > The key word to vs.6 is futility
- Memphis was the capital of Egypt, settled by Menes
- > It had an enormous necropolis
- > "Weeds will inherit them, and thorns their homes"
- Qimmos a particular species of plant-pest
