


STAGES ALONG THE WAY

- The role that Jesus plays in Redemption History is crucial to understand
- Redemption is more complex than what is found only in the Gospels
- A framework is needed to understand something so cosmic in its enormity as Redemption History





- > Christ's firm conviction is that He is the Son of Man
- His understanding is in the context of Daniel chapter 7
- Daniel's vision included monstrous animals that represented 4 earthly kingdoms (empires)
- After those 4 kingdoms came and went, the Son of Man would come to set up, and rule over, God's Kingdom... The Kingdom of Heaven


- Eschatology = study of End Times matters
- We all wish for a precise biblical flow-chart of End Times events
- 1st century Jews thought that the End was at hand
- The Book of Revelation is helpful to understand timing and sequence of End Times events
- But it was Yeshua who added the most, and His timeline had similarities to then current beliefs



FLOW-CHART OF REDEMPTION HISTORY







- A flow; not independent generations as with start and stop points
- With Dispensations what came before vanishes and becomes alien
- So... Only 1 Covenant at a time can operate
- Each new Covenant abolishes the previous
- WRONG! Each stage is dependent upon the previous, with the memory and substance of it retained

CREATION TO FALL

The NEED for Redemption is created

FALL TO NOAH Wickedness increased, so God purged the earth except for 8 people

NOAH TO ABRAHAM God made a Covenant with Abraham that created a special people group to serve Him

ABRAHAM TO MOSES The special group became the 12 tribes, and they went to Egypt where they became slaves


MOSES TO JOHN FIRST REDEMPTION The Law is given to Moses, Israel rescued from Egypt, John inaugurates the Kingdom of Heaven

JOHN TO M. KINGDOM

SECOND REDEMPTON Jesus proclaims the Kingdom of Heaven, and forgiveness of sins

RE-CREATION

New Universe created. Evil destroyed. All is eternal. REDEMPTION COMPLETED




- The VISIBLE proof of the arrival of the Kingdom of Heaven was Yeshua driving out demons
- Yeshua coming in the 1st century represented some, but not all, of what the Son of Man would do
- Few of His followers grasped this, thought they were living in the End Times, and so were willing to pay any cost to spread the Gospel of forgiveness of sins



WHAT JOHN THE BAPTIST BELIEVED

- 1) Living in a present age of wickedness
- 2) Son of Man comes and the Great Judgment happens simultaneously
- 3) After that, the End of the World



WHAT YESHUA TAUGHT

- 1) Righteous living beside the wicked in the present age
- 2) Upon John, Son of Man appeared, along with the Kingdom of Heaven and forgiveness of sins
- 3) Later in the future, the Son of Man would come again
- 4) Then a new heavens and earth



- John the Baptist ushered in the Kingdom of Heaven, but would not be part of it Matthew 11:11
- We are somewhere in the 6th stage (of my flow-chart)
- Since it's been 2000 years since John, we are likely very far along in that stage
- The next stage begins with the return of the Son of Man as the Great Judge and King of the Kingdom of Heaven
