
There will be... A 3rd Temple



- Daniel's End Times prophecy requires a 3rd Temple
- Daniel chapter 7 is primary, but chapter 9 also adds more information
- It's the Angel Gabriel that makes Daniel's vision "clear" to him




THE CHANGING TONE OF BIBLE COMMENTARIES

- Tone change started to appear after the mid-20th century
- From a discovery of what God said, to doubt about the veracity of the Bible
- Israel's return seems to have been a turning point


THE DANIEL CONTROVERSY

- Daniel carried off to Babylon in the 6th century B.C.
- Later Bible scholars say that Daniel was actually written in 160 B.C.
- Recorded history says Bible was translated to Greek in 250 B.C.
- DSS written about 100 B.C.
- Greek Daniel and DSS Hebrew Daniel the same!



COPIES OF COPIES

- Copies were hand written
- The oldest Bible manuscripts are copies, not the originals!
- Occasional errors occurred when copying
- Christ clearly stated
 His trust in Daniel by
 embracing the Son of
 Man concept to Himself



ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION



- The original Abomination of Desolation happened 2 centuries before Yeshua
- "...let the reader understand the allusion.."
- The allusion must mean that what happened before is going to happen again, similarly
- Wicked prince to put image of himself in the Temple... did NOT happen with Roman destruction of Temple in 70 A.D.
- This must occur in the future in a 3rd Temple

THE FUTURE DESECRATION




- For the desecration to occur:
- > 1) Israel re-born
- 2) Jerusalem Jewish control... And Temple Mount Jewish control
- 3) Temple given green light to be re-built by international agreement
- 1 has happened, only the first part of 2 has happened, 3 has not
- We cannot have entered into the End Times just yet

FLEE TO THE HILLS!

- Once the Anti-Christ is revealed, things start to move quickly
- ➤ The terms used were appropriate for the 1st century, but it will be different in modern times
- Travel will be involved, so children, winter, and Sabbath add to the complexities
- Sabbath laws will make some hesitate to go





Vs. 21 "...for there will be thlipsis..." No THE

Thlipsis = literally means pressure; as a metaphor it means affliction, troubles, oppression

 There's no named events called THE Tribulation and THE Great Tribulation

Similar to saying pain and great pain


Daniel 12:1

The afflictions (tribulations) will be so bad that only divine intervention saves the "Chosen"


What does it mean to be chosen?

- Mark 13:20 Uses both "chosen" and "elect"
- > "The elect" seems to be a group, "the chosen" are individuals... But what is the criteria to be chosen?
- Psalm 105: 6 & 43 bachiyr = chosen, always refers to the Hebrew people
- > P'shat sense, the Holy Land and the Jewish Believers
- Remez sense, globally and includes all Gentile and Jewish Believers

- "At that time" = at the worst of the afflictions
- False Messiahs and false Prophets appear at the same time
- Any old Jesus is not the true Jesus
- Who Christ is goes beyond mere ethnic Jewishness
- He is the sum of ALL of His attributes
- Not finding the true Yeshua means finding a false Messiah



Not everyone who says to Me: "Lord, Lord!!"



- ➤ Matt.7:21 23
- These false Messiahs will be very convincing
- This is because they will meet the expectations of our Traditions and of our imaginings
- They will be the ultimate wolves in nearly undetectable sheep's clothing
- So how do "the chosen" not be fooled?
