



- > The Law and the Gospel of Christ are connected
- > They serve 2 critical, but different, purposes
- God gave us both, because we need both
- Both the Law AND the Gospel were given to Israel, and only later was the Gospel taken to gentiles

- Vs. 25 explainsVs. 24
- Jews skeptical:
- 1) Believed being Jewish brought them righteousness
- 2) They didn't see Messiah as part of a direct involvement in their relationship with God
- Paul is skeptical that these Believing
 Jews of Rome know the right doctrine







YESHUA THE MERCY SEAT


- Blood of Yeshua meets the Torah requirement of blood to atone for sin
- Hilasterion = kapparah
- Kapparah = Mercy Seat
- Since Babylonian exile, there was no Ark of the Covenant in the Holy of Holies
- Blood was sprinkled on the floor!!



WHOSE FAITH?

- Our faith? It takes a change in word order to make it that
- Yeshua's faith?
 Complies with the Greek word and verb order
- We are to trust in Christ's perfect faithfulness
- Our faith will never be perfect

- God's righteous = His saving will
- Human righteous = doing right, or being right before God
- God passed over past sins and postponed punishment until Yeshua came
- Sinner whose sins are atoned for:
- > 1) doesn't deserve it
- > 2) hasn't earned it
- > 3) is given as a free gift
- God is the God of Jews and gentiles








- Paul's "ruling": Since there is only one God, then He righteouses the circumcised and the uncircumcised based on their trust
- Since the Law doesn't save, does that mean that it is abolished?
 HEAVEN FORBID !!
- Matthew 5:17 19

ROMANS CHAPTER 4: A MIDRASH ON GENESIS 15:6

- Paul says trusting confirms the Law of Moses
- Z'kut Avot = merit of the Fathers
- Jews believed that Abraham was righteous on account of his deeds
- NT redemption is directly connected to Abraham
- Law didn't exist until 600 years after Abraham
- Book of Jubilees: "Abraham was perfect in all his deeds..."



WORKS AND DEEDS







- An analogy: a person who works for a wage isn't paid as a "favor" (a gift)
- He has earned it by his hard labors
- ▶ If a person doesn't work but only receives righteousness through trust, he has not earned it and so it is a gift
- Paul uses Psalm 32 to help interpret Gen.15:6
- God forgives and gives
 righteousness to sinners even
 though they don't deserve it

- "The way you are to go" = Law of Moses
- Psalm 32:10 "Grace surrounds those who trust.."
- Grace is an OT principle
- Grace is an attribute of God
- The Law was grace because an animal could pay the price for human sin
- Abraham was righteoused BEFORE he was circumcised
- He was not circumcised until 29 years after Gen. 15:6
- Circumcision is a sign of trusting!







SIN WAS(S) TRANSGRESSION OF THE LAW. (1 JOHN 3:4)

FOR PAUL, THE LAW IS NOT DEAD

- Israel was delivered (redeemed) before they received the Law
- Their redemption from Egypt was God's grace
- > Israel did not earn it or merit it
- > 1John 3:4
- The Law remained the standard
- There is only 1 Law because there is only 1 God
