
WIDOWS AND REMARRIAGE



- Romans 7:1 3 is about a widow remarrying; is being used as an illustration of "died to the law"
- The Torah does NOT address a widow remarrying except by Levirate marriage
- Paul is quoting Halakhah (Tradition), not a Law of Moses
- "The Law" = Jewish abbreviation of The Law of Moses

WHO OR WHAT DIED?





COMING ON

- "Died to The Law"
- Did The Law die? Or did the Believer die? The Law remains alive!
- The Believer had the change of "status", not the Law
- Modern Christian view of sin: anything God doesn't want me to do
- Sin DOES have a standard
- > 1John 3:4
- Should we go on sinning because Christ paid the price? Heaven Forbid!






WAKE UP!!!

- You now KNOW what Scripture says about The Law
- You now KNOW that you don't have your own customized standard of sin
- Do you want to live in eternity as the LEAST in God's Kingdom because you refuse to obey or to alter your lifestyle to conform to God's standards?

- Romans 7:6 alludes to fulfilled prophecy
- ▶ Jeremiah 31:30 32
- Law consists of two parts:
 Blessings for obedience,
 Curses for disobedience
- We are NOT released from the Blessings of the Law
- But we ARE released from the Curses of the Law
- Curses = condemnation = death

THE CURSE OF THE LAW IS DEATH





- Spirit of the Law is over and against the Letter of the Law
- Spirit = acting within the God-principle behind each Law
- <u>Letter</u> = rigid, mechanical, technical, ignoring the underlying God principles
- Yeshua spoke about the Spirit of the Law in His Sermon On the Mount
- "Going BACK to the Law"? ONLY Believers are equipped to properly know and carry out The Law

Was the Torah born defective?

Did it have to be replaced with a new and better one?

Did God promise life and security to Israel, but all it led to was sin?

- ➤ Deut. 30:10 20
- Did the Lord pull a baitand-switch on His Believers?
- If God would do this, why should we believe He wouldn't do it again?




IS GOD'S SOLUTION: NO MORE LAWS ??



- Nowhere does Deuteronomy or the Torah say that its sole purpose is to show us what sin is
- Standard way Paul speaks: he highlights certain aspects of his subject
- The Law has been exploited by sin for its own wicked purposes
- No laws = no crimes = no criminals
- The Law is holy, just and good
- The problem is NOT with The Law, the problem is with those who disobey The Law



- Paul's straw man says that somehow over time The Law went from good and pure to corruption and death
- Paul responds: Heaven Forbid !!
- Believers hanging suspended between Christ's death and His resurrection, as living ironies
- We are changed....but not entirely
- We are holy....but not entirely
- We have God's Spirit in us, but we also house the evil inclination



- Nomos (law) appears numerous times with several different meanings
- In verse 21 "law" is a general word indicating a metaphor (laying down the law)
- Paul's "inner self" is his regenerated mind
- This part of him loves God's Torah and The Law
- His "other parts" operate based on sin's laws

- The Law of Moses is woven throughout the Book of Romans
- The Law is the Rosetta Stone to understand Yeshua and the New Testament
- Paul realizes his predicament: some solved by Christ, some in progress
- Paul: "What a miserable creature I am!"
- The condition of the Believer:
- 1) Inner mind given over to God and His Laws
- 2) Other parts follow sin's law and so we stumble
